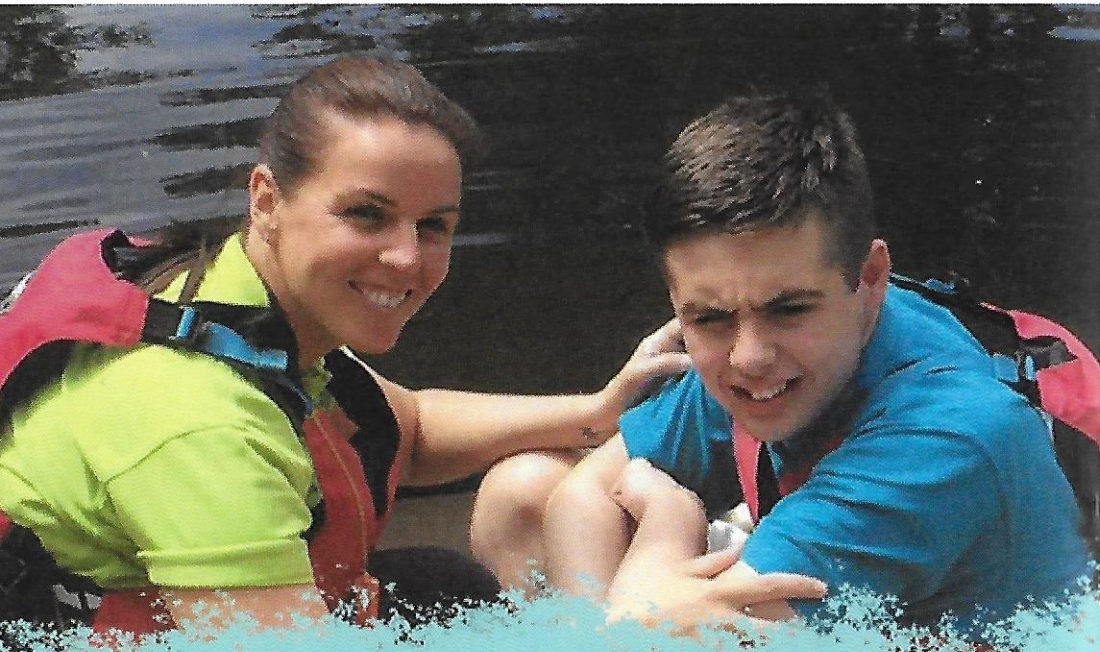
At Newlands we pride ourselves on our gentle teaching methods. We respect individual needs and create an autism friendly environment that is perfect for learning and development.
